

## **SUNY Fredonia-Hudson Valley Community College Articulation Agreement in Communication**

By this agreement, students who complete the Associate in Applied Science in Broadcast Communications at Hudson Valley Community College are guaranteed admission with full junior standing to the Bachelor of Science in Communication degree program at SUNY Fredonia. By completing the AAS degree and a minimum of 7/10 SUNY General Education requirements at Hudson Valley, such students should be able to complete their BS/BA degree at SUNY Fredonia within 4 additional-full time semesters, taking a minimum of 15-18 credits per semester.

### **Major Options**

BS Video Production

BA Journalism

\*\*\* Students earning the BS in Communication must complete an approved minor or study abroad program. Students should begin work in their minor at Hudson Valley. Please refer to the Fredonia catalog for approved minors. Minors are a minimum of 18 credit hours.

\*\*\*\* Students earning a degree from Fredonia must complete a minimum of 66 credits outside the major.

**GPA Criteria:** To be guaranteed admission, students must have a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 or higher.

**SUNY General Education Categories:** This is referred to as the College Core Curriculum (CCC) at Fredonia. Students must complete a minimum of 7 of the required 10 courses. Fredonia requires students to complete courses in all 10 categories. Furthermore:

- 1) Students are required to complete 2 courses in two different prefixes in the social sciences.
- 2) Students are required to complete 2 courses in two different prefixes in the natural sciences.
- 3) Students completing a BA degree in Journalism are required to satisfy the two semester foreign language proficiency requirement; through the 116 level at Fredonia or the 101 level at Hudson Valley.
- 4) The CCC includes a speaking intensive requirement. This will be fulfilled if students complete the basic communication requirement at Hudson Valley.

**Duration of Agreement**

This agreement will become effective in June 2012 and shall be reviewed every two years, or earlier, if significant changes are made in either the two-year or the four-year program.
