# INSURANCE

The UnitedHealthcare health insurance policy offered through SUNY is mandatory for all international students and scholars enrolled within the state system. International scholars with J-1 exchange/visitor, researcher, and professor visa status are also required to enroll in the policy, but are exempt if enrolled in the SUNY Graduate Assistant policy. Some students and scholars may be able to waive out of the program if they show proof of comparable major medical coverage. Please contact the ISS Office for more information on obtaining a waiver.
